

## VIEWING YOUR RESULTS

The results of your search are presented to you 10 at a time in the order that you specified.

## VIEWING AN ARTICLE

To view the full-text of an article click on the blue title link: e.g.

[Theatrical Proximities: The Stratford Festival 1998](#)

You will also find the following options below the title:

[Citation](#) | [Page of First Match](#) | [Print](#) | [Download](#) | [Save Citation](#)

- The **Citation link** will give you the full details of the article e.g. Title, Author, Volume, Date, etc.
- **Page of First Match** will give you the page of the article where your keywords first appear
- **Print** will allow you to print the article
- **Download** will give you options to choose the format of the article, e.g. Pdf format, Tiff format or Postscript format
- If you are working through a long list of articles, you can save the ones that look interesting by clicking on **Save Citation**. Once you have worked through your list you can click on VIEW SAVED CITATIONS to explore your saved articles in more depth.

## The Scholarly Journal Archive



### What is JSTOR?

It is an online database containing full-text journal articles. The subjects covered in JSTOR are:

- **General Science** (7 journals)
- **Language and Literature** (48 journals)
- **Music** (32 journals)

## DO I NEED A PASSWORD?

To use JSTOR from a St Martin's computer no passwords are needed.

If you would like to access JSTOR from home you will need to have a personal **Athens** username and password. To get these click on the **databases** link from the library web site and fill in the **Online Athens Request Form**. Alternatively please see a member of library staff.

## ACCESSING JSTOR

- Go to the library web site at:

- Click on the **Resources for Your Subject** link
- Choose your subject from the list
- Choose **Multidisciplinary Databases**
- Scroll down the table until you reach JSTOR
- Click on the blue JSTOR link
- You will now see the JSTOR home page
- If you are using an off-campus computer click on the **ACCESS VIA ATHENS** link at the bottom of the screen

## SEARCHING JSTOR

**Basic Search** lets you quickly perform a search by entering multiple keywords in the search boxes.

1. From the home page choose **search**
2. Enter your keywords in the boxes provided
3. Use the drop-down menus next to the keyword boxes to choose where you would like your keywords to be found, e.g. in the full text of the article or the title.
4. Select your discipline e.g. Science, Language and Literature or Music
5. You are now given 2 options to refine your search, by **type** and **date**.
6. Choose how you would like your results to be displayed using the **Sort Results** menu
7. Click on the **Begin Search** Button

**TIP:** Specify dates as yyyy, yyyy/mm or yyyy/mm/dd.
